Preparation for your colonoscopy or surgery:

You will start your preparation the day before your procedure. You will start a clear liquid diet and continue for the remainder of the day which will consist of the following: start liquids on up until midnight

- 1. Water (plain, carbonated, or flavored)
- 2. Sports drinks (Gatorade, Powerade)
- 3. Clear broth, bullion, or consommé
- 4. Soda pop (sprite, 7up, ginger ale)
- 5. Jell-O any color (no fruit)
- 6. Coffee and teas (no creamer or milk)
- 7. Kool-Aid or Crystal Lite
- 8. Apple juice, cranberry juice (without pulp)
- 9. Hard candies
- 10. Sugar or sugar substitute
- 11. Popsicles without milk, bits or fruit, seeds or nuts

Not Allowed

- 1. Milk, cream, or milk products
- 2. Orange juice, tomato juice, grapefruit juice
- 3. Alcohol
- 4. Any liquid you cannot see through

<u>Very Important</u>: NO ASPIRIN OR ANY ANTI-INFLAMATORY MEDICATIONS (ALEVE, ADVIL, MOTRIN, VITAMIN E, FISH OIL, OR <u>BLOOD THINNERS</u>). BEGINNING 7 DAYS PRIOR TO THE PROCEDURE. TYLENOL IS THE SAFEST MEDICATION TO TAKE. STOP ANY HERBAL MEDS (IE.: GINKOBA, GARLIC, GINSENG, ETC.)

THE DAY OF THE PROCEDURE, IF NECESSARY, ONLY TAKE BLOOD PRESSURE MEDICATION WITH A SIP OF WATER & HOLD OFF ON ANY OTHER MEDS UNTIL AFTER THE PROCEDURE.

Bowel preparation for your procedure (Follow these instructions NOT the ones on the Box)

Suprep Bowel prep Kit both 6-ource bottles are required for a complete prep. <u>Note: DILUTE THE SOLUTION</u> CONCENTRATE AS DIRECTED PRIOR TO USE. DRINK ALL THE LIQUID IN THE CONTAINER.

FIRST DOSE: to be stated @ 1pm on:

YOU MUST DRINK TWO ADDITIONAL 16 OUNCE CONTAINERS OF WATER OVER THE NEXT HOUR

SECOND DOSE: 5pm on:

YOU MUST DRINK TWO ADDITIONAL 16 OUNCE CONTAINERS OF WATER OVER THE NEXT HOUR

THE DAY OF THE PROCEDURE IF NECESSARY, TAKE BLOOD PRESSURE MEDICATION WITH SIP OF WATER.

- 4. *****PER DR KARDYS Patients must call the office after a colonoscopy, Flexible sigmoidoscopy or EGD & schedule a follow up Telmed visit 7-14 days after procedure.

Please note: Your surgical procedure is performed in a room which must be reserved well in advance. Due to the complexity of scheduling, cancellations must only be in cases of emergencies.
