This information has been prepared to assist you. PLEASE READ IT CAREFULLY. If you have any questions, please call the doctor's office listed below during regular business hours.

<u>TRANSPORTATION:</u> You will be sedated for the procedure. <u>YOU WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO DRIVE</u> <u>YOURSELF HOME.</u> Please, make arrangements to have someone drive you home after the procedure. Allow approximately 2-3 hours from arrival to departure.

<u>MEDICATIONS:</u> DO NOT take aspirin or ibuprofen products at least 5 days prior to your procedure. If you are taking a prescribed blood thinner, please call your physician to be sure it will be o.k. to stop 5 days. If you are taking blood pressure, heart, or any critical medications continue to take them on your regular schedule, even the morning of the procedure with a sip of water only. DO NOT take diabetes medications on the morning of your procedure until you are allowed to eat again. **Invokana** (canagliflozin), **Farxiga** (dapagliflozin) and **Jardiance** (empagliflozin) should be discontinued for at least 3 days prior to procedure. **Stelgatro** (ertugliflozin) should be discontinued for a least 4 days prior to procedure.

<u>Preparation Day Before Procedure:</u> You must be on a clear liquid diet only on the day before the procedure. This includes all you want of broth, Jello, popsicles, fruit juices without pulp, soda, water, coffee and tea. Please <u>do not have anything red the day before.</u> This may be confused with blood during the procedure. <u>No cream or sugar in coffee the morning of procedure.</u>

***You will be given a prescription for a <u>Sutab Bowel Prep Kit</u> that can be taken to the pharmacy of your choice. <u>Take each set of pills over 60-90 minutes.</u>

<u>3pm day before procedure</u> Take the first bottle of Sutab. Take the 12 tablets over 60-90 minutes drinking at least three 16 oz cups of any clear liquid, just not red in color.

<u>9pm day before procedure</u> Take the second bottle of Sutab. Take 6 tablets over 60-90 minutes drinking at least three 16 oz cups of any clear liquid, just not red in color.

<u>4 hour prior to procedure</u>: Take the remaining 6 tablets of Sutab over 60-90 minutes and again follow with three 16 oz cups of any clear liquid, just not red in color.
