Preparation for your colonoscopy or surgery:

You will start your preparation the day before your procedure. You will start a clear liquid diet and continue for the remainder of the day which will consist of the following: start liquids on up until midnight

- 1. Water (plain, carbonated, or flavored)
- 2. Sports drinks (Gatorade, Powerade)
- 3. Clear broth, bullion, or consommé
- 4. Soda pop (sprite, 7up, ginger ale)
- 5. Jell-O any color (no fruit)
- 6. Coffee and teas (no creamer or milk)
- 7. Kool-Aid or Crystal Lite
- 8. Apple juice, cranberry juice (without pulp)
- 9. Hard candies
- 10. Sugar or sugar substitute
- 11. Popsicles without milk, bits or fruit, seeds or nuts

Not Allowed

- 1. Milk, cream, or milk products
- 2. Orange juice, tomato juice, grapefruit juice
- 3. Alcohol
- 4. Any liquid you cannot see through

<u>Very Important</u>: NO ASPIRIN OR ANY ANTI-INFLAMATORY MEDICATIONS (ALEVE, ADVIL, MOTRIN, VITAMIN E, FISH OIL, OR BLOOD THINNERS). BEGINNING 7 DAYS PRIOR TO THE PROCEDURE.

TYLENOL IS THE SAFEST MEDICATION TO TAKE. STOP ANY HERBAL MEDS (IE.: GINKOBA, GARLIC, GINSENG, ETC.)

THE DAY OF THE PROCEDURE, IF NECESSARY, ONLY TAKE BLOOD PRESSURE MEDICATION WITH A SIP OF WATER & HOLD OFF ON ANY OTHER MEDS UNTIL AFTER THE PROCEDURE.

Follow these instructions:

Fill the prescription for Golytely, Nulytely, Polyethylene or Colyte)

- Mix the laxative preparation as directed on the label & place it in the refrigerator for a few hours to chill before drinking
- At 7:00pm the day before the procedure begin drinking the laxative preparation (Golytely, Nulytely, PEG -3550, Polyethylene or Colyte). Drink one-8-ounce glass every 10 minutes until the entire bottle is consumed. You should complete drinking the laxative preparation by 10:00 pm. Drink the preparation with a straw, this may make it easier to consume. You may add the flavor packet provided with the medication but do not add additional flavoring to the liquid.
- If you experience vomiting stop drinking the preparation for 20-30 minutes, then restart & finish the remainder of the preparation. If you are unable to finish the due to vomiting call a Medical Assistant @ Texas Oncology Colon & Rectal Physician's office # 210-614-0880.

THE DAY OF THE PROCEDURE IF NECESSARY, TAKE BLOOD PRESSURE MEDICATION WITH SIP OF WATER.

Please note: Your surgical procedure is performed in a room which must be reserved well in advance. Due to the complexity of scheduling, cancellations must only be in cases of emergencies.
